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# Fashion Supply List 2023

## Certificate III Compulsory Items

### Stationery:

- 2B pencils, sharpener and eraser
- 2 x biros
- 2 x Fine liner pens (.2, .4 & .6mm)
- Mechanical Pencils (.5mm e.g. Pacer type) + extra leads
- Coloured texta/markers (a basic 18 or 24 pack)
- Coloured pencils (a basic 18 or 24 pack)
- Glue stick
- Correction tape
- Tape dispenser (small) + Tape (Magic/invisible tape and regular sticky tape)
- Stapler (small) + Staples
- Ruler (30cm)
- 4 x A4 Lever Arch Folders (Machining; Patternmaking; Design and Fibres & Fabrics)
- 100 Pack A4 8mm ruled loose leaf paper
- 100 Pack A4 Plastic Pockets/Sheet Protectors (smaller packs can get you started, however 100 may be more economical)
- A4 Dividers
- Earphones/headset for computer and online classes
- 1 x 55-60 litre Tub (for storage of everyday items and stationery. This will be placed under your table)
- USB Flash Drive
- Large pencil case

## Basic Sewing Kit:

NB. You may already have some sewing kit items at home. Along with the stationary list, student should bring the basic sewing kit items marked with an asterisk \* to class on the first day. Staff will explain other items without an asterisk on the first day to help guide your purchases.

- Chalk wheel/pencil
- Pilot frixion erasable pen
- Glass or pearl head pins \*
- Thread cutters (small thread snippers) \*
- Awl Tool
- Un-picker/Seam Ripper \*
- Dressmakers Tape Measure \*
- Fabric Scissors
- Paper Scissors \*
- Measuring Gauge (Sewing & Knitting Gauge) \*
- Long handled tweezers
- Regular hand-sewing needles

To purchase later in the year when instructed to:

- Embroidery and Alteration needle requirements:
  - Beading needle
  - Embroidery needle/crewel
  - Transfer paper

Please do not purchase rulers until your teacher has discussed options in class.

- Metric Full Scale Ruler
- Metric 1/3 Scale Ruler
- Metric French Curve Ruler
- Tracing Wheel (pattern making)

- Artist Colour Wheel Mini (optional)

## Computer/IT Requirements:

Access to the internet and a computer (or laptop) outside of TAFE to participate in online classes, access resources, watch training video tutorials and to complete electronic work. A working computer camera and microphone (or headset) is required to enable participation in online class sessions.

## Other Compulsory Fee “Other Fees”

A materials fee of \$100 will cover the following resources used during the course:

- Calico/fabric for testing toiles
- Sample cut fabric bundles for all learning tasks
- Haberdashery (for learning samples - zips, buttons, thread, interfacing)

### Fabric Note –

Certificate III students will have access to basic TAFE fabrics for course work, however they can also purchase their own fabric which may be better suited to their design. If students elect to purchase their own fabrics they must be guided by their teacher.
