Why do a 'SKILL UP' course at TasTAFE?

- **NO FEE SKILL UP** courses are nationally accredited - which means your certificate will be recognised and valued right across Australia.
- SKILL UP courses will take a few days to just weeks to complete, enabling you to quickly gain new skills or build on your existing skills!
- Some SKILL UP courses are fully online, and others are a blend of online learning combined with practical activities on campus.

Civil Construction Entry Level Program

TASMSS0194 – Lay the foundations to work in Civil Construction with a strong base of essential skills in this practical program. Included is compulsory White Card training needed to work in this industry! You'll learn how to use a stop-slow bat, how to operate a radio, and how to direct traffic.

Pruning and Vineyard Establishment

TASMSS0192 – Do you enjoy working outside? The Tasmanian wine industry needs skilled workers at vineyards across the state. Get the skills you need for vine pruning and establishment with this course! You'll gain the skills and knowledge to train vines for different grape varieties. This course also includes how to take and process vine cuttings using a variety of hand-held equipment.

Planting Vines, Pest and Canopy Management

TASMSS0191 – If you're starting out in the industry, this short course is a great first step. It would also be valuable if you're looking to establish your own vineyard!

You will learn how to plant cuttings and rootlings by hand and gain skills in basic wine grapevine canopy maintenance using manual and motorised equipment.

Intro to Cookery

TASMSS0193 – If you're looking for employment in restaurants, hotels, cafes, bars, pubs or catering facilities, set yourself up for success with this course!

You will gain experience working in a commercial kitchen setting and learn how to select, and safely use, the right equipment for the food being prepared. This course also includes preparing and presenting a range of simple dishes.

Restaurant Service Essentials

TASMSS0182 – Kickstart your hospitality career with this short course which includes your Responsible Service of Alcohol qualification!

You will get hands-on experience in a working restaurant environment, including food and beverage service as well as gain the skills and knowledge to interact confidently with customers. You will also learn how to prepare and serve a great espresso coffee!



Introduction to Bar

TASMSS0183 – Can you see yourself working behind a bar? Be prepared with these essential bar skills plus your Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) qualification. You will gain the skills and knowledge required to prepare a bar for service, take drink orders, prepare and serve alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages and close the bar down.

Workplace Computing

TASMSS0189 – Technology changes quickly. Do you feel like you're being left behind? If you need to update your computing skills, this short course is a great place to start! You learn about the common software used in workplaces to create written documents, spreadsheets and presentations. You will also learn how to work with files and folders, as well as basic cloud-based computing, including storage.



Develop Your Digital Skills

TASMSS0169 – This course is ideal if you have an interest in design concepts and are looking to expand your current knowledge and skills in digital media.

This fast-paced course will provide you with the skills and knowledge you need to undertake research and review digital media packages. You'll undertake tasks where you'll incorporate graphics, moving images and sound, according to a design brief.

Cost – No Fees!

TasTAFE SKILL UP courses are no fee courses funded by the Tasmanian State Government.

Eligibility

To study a **SKILL UP** course, you must be:

Tasmanian Resident

- A resident of Tasmania or working in Tasmania.

Citizenship

- an Australian citizen, or
- an Australian permanent resident, or
- a New Zealand citizen

Visa

If not a citizen as above, on a state sponsored visa on a pathway to permanent residence.

Note: It is *mandatory for all TasTAFE students to be fully vaccinated. COVID-19 vaccination evidence (first and second dose) will be required at time of enrolment:

*Exemptions:

- Evidence of a medical exemption, or
- if your SKILL UP course is delivery fully online.

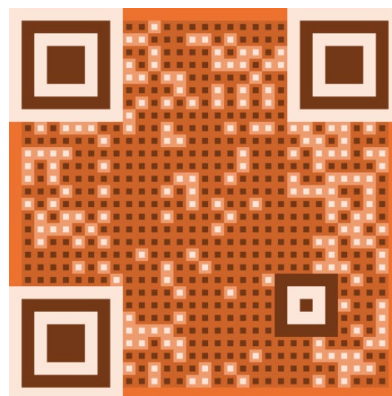
