

## Frequently Asked Questions

The below questions have been compiled from our most recent information session.

- "What level of language proficiency does this course require the applicants to meet, given she is a permanent visa holder?" Desirable level 3 English as you to be able to communicate with you client. If you do please contact Hair and Beauty team and will provide the English Language Services contact details.
- I have attained my Certificate II in Hairdressing, but I really want to do Certificate III barbering instead of Certificate III in Hairdressing. Is this possible? Yes, it is desirable to have a current certificate II in salon assistant
- How many spaces are available at Hobart? There is one class available in the Hobart region.
- How many spaces are available in the Devonport campus for the Barbering course? There is one class available in the Devonport region.
- If I'm working in a salon as a barber can my boss tick me off quicker? To make it less than two years?

Your boss will not be able to sign you off, the time could be reduced slightly if you complete all required assessments successfully."

- "Is there an option for block training in Barbering, or any of the courses?" Block training is not available due to classroom availability.
- Is work placement a requirement of the barbering course? Work placement is not a requirement but is highly recommended to take advantage of this valuable experience.
- "If I'm working at a barber shop receiving training and experience, would my course be shortened?"

Course duration depends on successful completion of all assessment requirements.



- What factors do you look at when deciding who is successful with their application? All applications open on the 9th of November, with equal opportunity
- Do I need everything in the kit to start with for barbering? You will be supplied with the kit at the start of your course.
- What if i find an apprenticeship during the course? Can i switch into the apprentice role • Yes, if you gain an apprenticeship you will be transferred over.
- I received my Certificate II in Hairdressing from Alanvale campus in 2007. Does this count as my pathway to allow me to apply for Certificate III in Hairdressing? Credit transfers will be given for units that map over to your new qualification.
- I have never done hairdressing before but I am interested to do it. I always watch videos on YouTube. Which certificate I should do? Certificate II in Salon Assistant as this is a pathway into the Certificate III courses.
- I already completed some of the course in 2018 in prison will I have to start from scratch again?

No. All units that you have successfully completed will be credit transfers.
