

## Frequently Asked Questions

The below questions have been compiled from our most recent information session.

- **Why is nail technology different days and times in the south compared to the North?**  
This is due to room availability; you will be completing a lot of theory in your own time as it's a combination of self-paced and classroom learning
- **I have a back injury; can I still do the course?**  
You will need to be able to sit and stand for long periods of the day and to be able to complete this course. You also need good dexterity skills to be able to use your hands to complete the practical tasks required
- **I have a holiday booked and will be away for 3 weeks, will I be able to catch up?**  
We recommend to utilise the school holidays where you can for any planned trips away the classes are fast paced and if you miss a lot it is very hard to catch up and you will not complete
- **How important is it that I can provide clients as timetabled?**  
You will need to be able to source your own clients for these courses. Models are a very important part of the practical learning and assessments; without them you will not complete. We recommend bringing your friends and family, we also have a list of TasTAFE clients you can access on campus.
- **Do I have to get a kit?**  
Yes this is a requirement to complete your training as the specialised tools, equipment and textbooks are required for the practical learning and assessment tasks
- **What about English is my second language?**  
You will need to have Level 3 English to be able to enrol in this course.
- **I can't read very well does that matter?**  
Although we do have support at TasTAFE for literacy and numeracy you will be required to understand the information being delivered
- **Can I do two courses at once?**  
It is very difficult to complete 2 x courses within hair and beauty at once due to the practical and theory requirements, so we recommend you focus on one course per year

- **What if I can't pay my fees in full, upfront?**

You will be required to pay either up front or you can arrange a payment instalment plan with a minimum 25% deposit for your qualification before the CENSUS date. The payment plan will be over a period of up to six months. In exceptional circumstances these plans can be extended.

CENSUS DATE - Early April – exact date to be advised on first day of class.

The total amount must be paid by the end of the year so you can receive your certificate.

- **Do I have to wear anything specific for my course?**

Yes you will be issued with a uniform top, along with that you will be required to wear black closed in shoes, black pants or knee length skirt and during practical sessions ensure your hair is tied up or back.

- **What if I use all the products in my kit practicing at home?**

There is enough product in your kit for the practical activities and assessments, so if you happen to use it all you will need to restock the kit at your own expense.
